Bosch[®] Crash Data Retrieval (CDR) Tool Course

This two-day course is best suited for field investigators, insurance investigators & adjusters, or those involved in vehicle documentation and examinations. The course offers the attendee insight into the basic operation and use of the Bosch[®] Crash Data Retrieval (CDR) Tool, as well as learning the latest software and basic data collection techniques.

The course will provide an understanding of the components of the Bosch[®] CDR Tool exposing the user to the basic functions of the hardware and software. The goal is for the user to confidently collect and preserve data from supported vehicles using the vehicles diagnostic (OBD-DLC) port, or in some cases directly from the airbag control module (ACM).

The hands-on practical exercises allow the attendees to collect data from various supported modules. Each attendee will receive individual or small group guided instruction in the following:

- ◇ Software overview (Legacy & CDR2)
- ◇ Evaluating vehicle condition for connection method
- ◇ In-vehicle DLC data collection
- ◇ Module location and identification including newly supported GM Active Safety & Front Camera modules
- ◇ Direct-to-module data imaging
- ◇ Practical booster and adaptor applications
- ◇ “Repowering” vehicles and airbag control modules to allow in-vehicle DLC data collection

Attendees are not required to own the Bosch[®] CDR Tool, although it is strongly encouraged. This course is designed so those who do not yet own the CDR tool will have a better understanding of this evolving technology and benefit from the information.

Individuals who successfully complete this course will receive a certificate of completion for the Bosch[®] CDR Tool (operator/technician). This course does *not* go into any analysis of the collected data, however it is a required prerequisite for some Bosch[®] CDR report data analysis courses.

Note: There will be a Hyundai, Kia, Tesla EDR Tool course Feb. 19th at the same location! \$635 for both classes
